## ALMA MATER

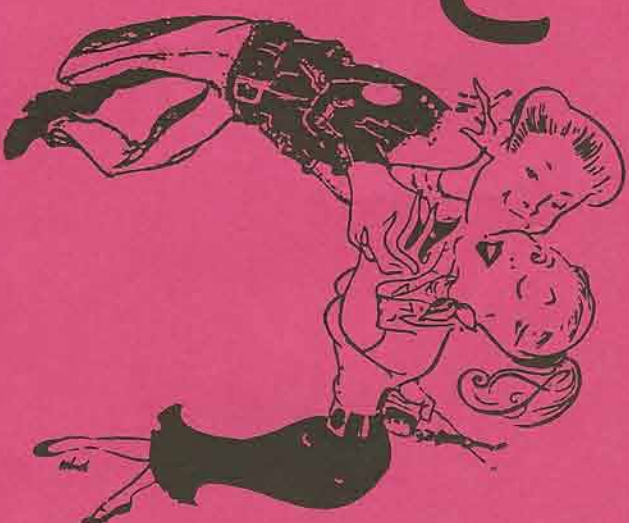
As I go travelling down life's highway,
