



Kirk's Ground Rod Installation KK6KC

It started with one 8ft rod installed in this hole with harvested Gypsum and Pool Salt





- 8ft away a second rod
- Fill- Gypsum/Epsom salts
- Installer Hammer drill with special ground rod tip
- Turns out this is too close to foundation



Had to install a third rod to go all the way down.








- Clamps connect rods to flexible copper
- Flexible copper inside shack with grounding point
- Much less noise with ground to radio



Remote Control for Auto-Tuner (Still in progress)

- Remote control of LDG YT-1200 Auto Tuner
- Relay "Pushes" Tune button
- Waits for the LED to come on and go out
- Raspberry Pi GPIO device
- Testing on Pi-ZeroW breadboard computer
- Program in Python
